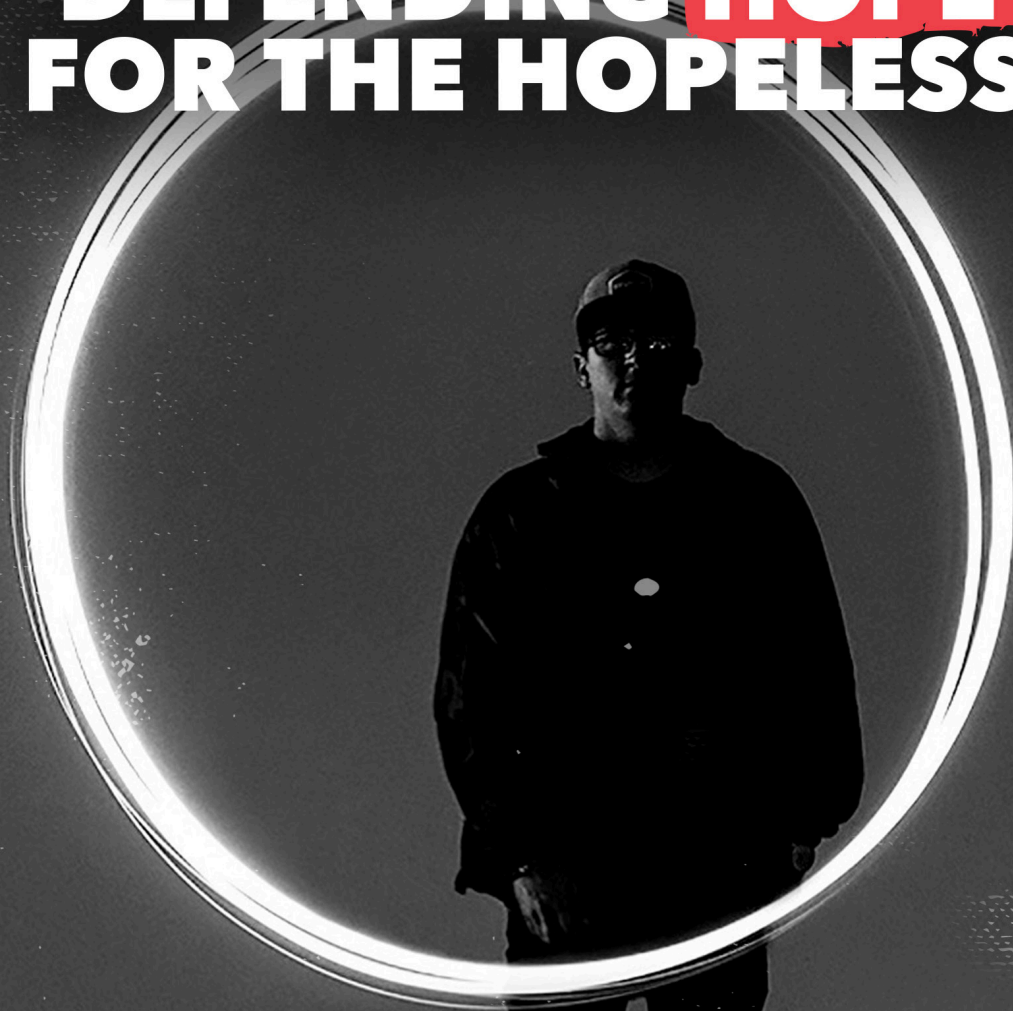

# HOW TO USE THIS STUDY GUIDE

---

## **BEFORE YOU BEGIN:**

This guide is a companion to our video series that is meant to help encourage healthy discussion, deep thinking, and forward motion. While this study is meant to help guide the discussion before and after each video, we encourage you to lead your group under Christ's direction and application. There will be times when you may feel angry, confused, anguished, or even emotionally exhausted. Be encouraged that these emotions were shared by Jesus Himself, who in His ministry, was overcome by compassion, righteous anger, and even sadness.

Throughout this study, you'll hear many stories, much information, and several calls for action. The purpose of this series is to provide actionable steps toward ending human trafficking in our communities, cities, states, and nation. As you engage, you will come to understand some of the underlining issues that cause trafficking such as abuse, belittling, neglect, abandonment, lack of resources, or the absence of hope.

We believe that the Church is called to be the hands and feet of Jesus in both practical and strategic ways to bring healing and hope to the abused and the broken. Even with the calls to action and practical resources included in this study, there truly is no one-size-fits-all to combat the atrocity of human trafficking. Therefore, we must remain humble and listen closely to the Holy Spirit to guide our actions within our spheres of influence. Above all, we must remember that Jesus is the only one capable of real transformation in our cities.

## **HOW THIS SERIES IS SET UP:**

This study is split into a 5-part series. It's very important to watch all episodes to fully understand the unadulterated truth about modern-day trafficking and how God has instructed us to respond in accordance with His scripture. We suggest that this series last no longer than 5 weeks (watching one video per week). However, you can easily decide to make this an intensive one-day or multi-day group study. Please use your discernment for your group or congregation as to what is best.

# HOW TO USE THIS STUDY GUIDE

## HELPFUL TIPS:

1. Use this more so as a guide and less like a script. Organic discussion and participation should be prioritized over “teaching.”
2. Don’t feel pressured to get through every question. If the Holy Spirit is driving the conversation, follow His lead.
3. This subject matter is, by nature, difficult to process emotionally. Please be mindful of those in the room and their opinions, personal backgrounds, possible triggers, and level of experience.
4. Try to stay away from politically charged conversations and arguments. Our purpose is not to promote a platform, but rather to transcend governmental ideologies and agencies as Christ-followers and citizens of the Kingdom, regardless of voter ID. Above all, seek peace, listen with humility, be kind, and use words that build each other up in love.
5. Ask God to lead the discussion and work in and through your group time.

## Takeaways

1. When working through this series, do not be anxious about jumping in to “fix the problem.” Try to fully understand and grasp each session until the end. We have many action points by that time for you to consider. Please try to take time to become educated and reflect on the material with God.
2. Some stories may trigger thoughts, memories, or emotions that have been hidden away for some time. If you feel you need to share something, please confide in a church leader, counselor, or trusted peer. As a group, be ready to possibly hear directly from members in your group or throughout your church.

3. What are some ways that we could demonstrate to victims of human trafficking that hope is not lost?

3. The prophet Isaiah warned the people of God (Israel) about their negligence in how they were serving the Lord. What did God say was the kind of worship that He desired from His people? Does this still apply today?

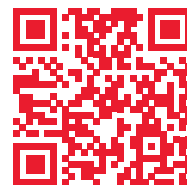

# SESSION TWO: ADVOCATE WITH LIGHT

---

## Takeaways

1. Anyone held against their will, whether by force, fraud, or coercion, is being exploited. Someone who is being exploited to perform commercial sex is being sex trafficked, and someone who is being exploited to perform labor is being labor trafficked (both “labor trafficking” and “sex trafficking” can fall under the term “human trafficking”).
2. Sex trafficking is not a victimless crime. Studies show that 90% of women want to get out of prostitution but feel trapped or simply do not know how as they feel that they do not have other opportunities or choices. This often begins in a place of desperation or hurt, and traffickers/pimps begin to groom these victims into believing that this is their only true worth.
3. While most cases of sex trafficking involve women and girls, there’s a rise in data showing that males are also being trafficked. Some of those studies show that up to 36% of trafficked children are males. Unfortunately, studies show that due to cultural perception of males, most boys are not identified as a victim by themselves or by authorities, and are instead perceived as culprits (that THEY are the ones who either choose to engage or allow themselves to be taken advantage of and are thus responsible for their actions).
4. Like Oree, most victims of sex trafficking have been sexually abused earlier in their life. Usually as a child.

1. In the beginning, Francis talks about how we sometimes find ourselves asking God why He didn't "do anything" [about a great sin or hurt caused by someone else to others]. But what would you say if God, in turn, asked "Why didn't you do anything?"
2. What are some new things you learned about modern-day trafficking in this episode?
3. Maybe not in extreme cases like trafficking, but have you ever been exploited by someone that gains your trust for their own personal gain? Have YOU ever exploited someone like this?
4. What are ways we can take action to make sure someone like Oree is never in a situation where someone watched and saw her, but did not say anything?

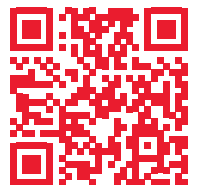

# SESSION THREE: ADVOCATE WITH TRUTH

---

## Takeaways

1. Grooming from traffickers or “pimps” (any perpetrator) often happens through a trusted relationship first. They find ways to target those who are or seem more vulnerable and more likely to feel affirmed by the care they show in the beginning of the relationship.
2. Many women are trafficked by their boyfriend (or someone they deeply care about) by being asked to do a one-time sexual act to help gain some money. This leads to further sexual acts and manipulation.
3. Traffickers often target children through social media apps and video games. It is important that we always know who our children might be communicating with.
4. Most victims of sex trafficking revert back to the life of trafficking. Some have said it takes 10-15 times before they stop returning.
5. Familial trafficking (trafficking within the family unit) accounts for over 30% of child sex trafficking in the United States. Many times, familial trafficking occurs from family members who were also trafficked or are currently being trafficked - which creates a generational pattern of familial trafficking, sexual abuse, addiction, and suicide.
6. Over 24% of trafficked victims were in foster care at one point as a child. Additionally, it is projected that between 60% and 70% of trafficked children in the U.S. come from child social services or the foster care system. This shows us that foster children are the most vulnerable group to being trafficked in their lifetime.

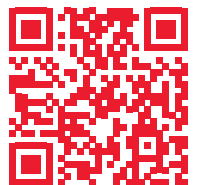
## KEY SCRIPTURE:

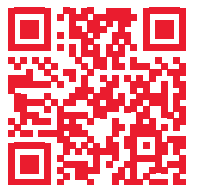

## Takeaways

1. Victims of sex trafficking need an extensive amount of help, support, resources, and patience during their recovery. It also takes trained and gifted professionals who know how to provide the necessary extensive care to these victims. As the Church, we have the unique opportunity to transcend political blockades and strategically help create and fund safe homes with these educated and trained professionals in every city of our nation.

Note: Without extensive education, it can actually harm a victim more than help them recover. It is important to partner with trained professionals before starting extensive care or homes. Please make sure to talk to someone currently running a safe home to become trained.
